“Celebrate Women” Tour Package (Brownies and Juniors)

This package for Brownie and Junior troops includes a self-guided tour at the House and activities to do at home. At the House, scouts use a scavenger hunt to see Mary Todd’s childhood home with a women’s history focus. When the troop leaves, they get House buttons (1 per scout), craft kits (2 per scout) and game instructions to do at home. The craft kits—designing a plate and making an “I Am” fan—are inspired by Mary Lincoln’s activities. The game puts a women’s history spin on cornhole.

“Celebrate Women” can be scheduled by calling the number above at least three weeks in advance.

Costs for “Celebrate Women” are \$6 per scout, \$6 per leader, \$10 per other adult chaperones.

Standard Self-Guided Tour (Brownies and up)

Regular self-guided tours for groups of more than 15 can be scheduled by calling the number above at least two weeks in advance.

Costs for regular self-guided tours are \$4 per scout, \$6 per leader, \$10 per other adult chaperones.

Scheduling and Logistics

Groups wishing to schedule after 4 p.m. must have a total of 15 or more (scouts, adults, and tag-alongs).

Full payment for the group by cash, check, or credit card is due on the day of the program. One payment per group. Group members may not pay separately.

There is free parking behind the museum. Groups may gather in the garden behind the House before the program begins.

The museum cannot be responsible for scouts if they are dropped off. At least one leader needs to arrive 15 minutes before the tour to supervise scouts who are dropped off. Parents should not leave children until they are certain a troop leader is present. The troop leader should meet the arriving scouts in the garden or parking lot behind the House.

The tour will begin at the scheduled time. Latecomers will need to join tours in progress.

Allow approximately 45 minutes for self-guided tours. Plan for additional time if visiting the museum store.
